SECRETS OF THE VATICAN

Jesus has been telling us
I watched the horrific documentary “Secrets of the Vatican” and I was so shocked, I haven’t been the same since. I always switched off when people started talking about the paedophile priests because I was so sick of hearing about it and I felt it had become a great excuse for people to stop going to Mass on Sunday and leave the Church. I also felt a lot of priests were accused in the wrong. However, this documentary really opened my eyes to the corruption within the Vatican which Jesus has been telling us about for years.

Preventing the further abuses

The documentary touched on child abuse by priests. In my opinion, the most damaging thing was the way the Church covered it up. Cardinal Ratzinger

was the head of discipline in the Church at the time and complaints, scandals, allegations must have been streaming through his hands. I believe if molestations had been reported to the police, those abusers would be behind bars, preventing the further abuses which happened when they were transferred to another parish. Then if this priest being brought to justice was publicised, it may have stopped others with this tendency, being afraid to commit this act. But instead it seemed that discretion was the way to go in the Church.

A mere tap on the wrist

Even the founder of the Legionaries of Christ, Marcial Maciel, was eventually exposed as a child abuser, as well as other crimes throughout eighty four years of his life, which included rape, misusing

funds, leading a double life and fathering children. He was told by the Church in 2006 to spend the rest of his life in prayer and penance - a mere tap on the wrist. He died in 2008, aged eighty seven, without ever having faced a trial.

Vatican bank

The documentary also talked about the scandals of the Vatican bank and how Cardinal Bertone was involved in its big clean up but had prevented anyone from seeing any historic transactions – covering up numerous allegations of permitting money laundering, the bank’s links to the Mafia and Iraq.

The most shocking of all

But, the most shocking of all - and the reason I haven’t been the same since - was an exposé from a prominent Italian investigative reporter, Carlo Abbate, in 2010.

Hypocrisy

Abbate's friend had just had gay sex with a priest and was then invited by this priest to a gay party where there would be lots of other priests and he had booked two male escorts as the entertainment. The undercover reporter, Carlo Abbate, and his friend went to this party. Abbate filmed the events with a hidden camera. The reporter's aim was to show the hypocrisy in the Church, how it was teaching one thing about homosexuality and letting its priests do another. He said there were many gay priests, particularly in Rome.

Priests

The priest who hosted the party was filmed dancing sexually with the two gay strippers that he had booked. Abbate said about half the people at the party were priests and they introduced themselves as such. Some worked in the Vatican, others worked in the institutions that clustered around it.

After this party everyone returned to Abbate's friend's house for an after party.

Celebrated Mass

Abbate's friend and a French priest locked themselves in a room. Abbate slept in another room. The next day, the most shocking thing of all happened. This French priest got up the next morning, pulled out his travel kit and celebrated Mass in this same place

where he had sex all night, in that atmosphere. The reporter caught this all on camera and it was shown on this documentary. Only for seeing it I wouldn't have believed it. It makes me go weak at the knees every time I think about it. Like, the blindness! The hypocrisy! The sacrilege!

Gay

The Vatican dismissed reports of gay priests and gay parties, saying it was only a few individuals!

Other gay men have told reporters that it is easy to meet a gay priest, they may see them at gay bars then see them on the altar the following Sunday. A gay man who works in the Vatican says there are many bishops and archbishops who are gay.

Another gay man had a relationship with a priest who used theology to justify his sin. He told his boyfriend he was giving him his body but his soul belonged to God, to the altar and when he took off his vestments he was just like everyone else yet this same priest was telling the congregation to suppress their homosexual tendencies as it is wrong!

Poor Jesus!

I can't help but feel sorry for Jesus. He has been seeing all this going on for years. I wonder what else does He see that we don't! Poor Jesus!

No wonder He relentlessly asked us for prayers and sacrifices for Pope John Paul

II! And no wonder John Paul wasn't in the Vatican too much, he went out travelling the world!

It seems the Vatican is full of darkness. I believe when John Paul died, the Light went out. I'm sure there are many good priests who are heart broken by what they see going on in the Vatican by their brother priests, we must pray for strength for them.

Do not have souls

Remember these Words?:

"...I tell you that there are many who walk in My Vatican who do not have souls. I did not create them, they are not Mine..." *Sunday 16 January 2000, for the Day of Love*

As early as 1997, Jesus told us that He had no place in the Vatican and asked us to become one for Him:

"...Shout My Name from the rooftops and let the people of this world become My Vatican for I no longer have a place in My Own. Look and see the Truth of My Words..." *Friday 26 December 1997*

Completely obliterated

I really think it is down to us to rebuild the Church, to be the Vatican, to hold on to the Truth. If Saint Francis, who started off by himself, can do it, surely we can too! All is not lost if the True Church is within us, within our hearts. The Church that Jesus created still exists, under all the mire the world can only see. I don't think there will be as much as a speck of dust left

of the physical vatican that is there now whenever Jesus Returns. I reckon it will be completely obliterated.

Message

It was the following Message that came to my mind after I watched the documentary. It was given in the middle of the night by Jesus when the two Patricks and a few others were in Soledad, the House of Prayer in Cosio, near Garabandal, Spain. Jesus gave it to Patrick and we were awakened to hear these urgent, scary Words from a very hurt God:

Monday 27 May 2002

Patrick:

My Jesus, you seem to be calling me but I am not sure. I do not know what is wrong, it almost seems like confusion around me. Please tell me what is happening.

Jesus:

My servant, it is I, trying to get through to you. It is I calling you to hear Me.

Patrick:

Please speak, Jesus, I am sorry that I did not understand.

Jesus:

My servant, My Words to you within My Solitude have gone unnoticed by you. Did you not understand what I was saying? Must I continue to give you Gifts that are not used?

The footprints of the evil one already muddy the floors of My Vatican and My Holy Father is in grave danger. I tell you this so that you will know and be in preparation for it.

My children who are with you

have not grasped the meaning of My Words. They will only die to a small part of themselves. I ask of you and My son to make it clear to them and to those within My Houses. Now is the time that I am depending upon all of you for your co-operation with Me. I am Warning all of My children that you are about to see even greater changes within My Church, as if they could change it anymore. These changes will not be subtle as they have been up to now but what has been spoken about in the darkness of their hearts will now come into the light as laws within My Church.

I have told you recently that I have been cut off from My Church. I tell you now that My Holy Father is being cut off as I speak these Words. My Church has become a remnant for many will go with the new laws that are already prepared and waiting. Soon you shall see the things that have only been speculated become a reality. Much confusion will enter My flock and they shall scatter and the shepherds will be no longer Mine even though they act as though they are.

Do you welcome Me with your self or with your dying to it? I Love you. Let these



Words penetrate you. Believe in it, believe My Words. Among you, little ones, you have hiding the Criminal that the world hates in favour of self. Will you hate Him too and despise Him? I Love you.

Deception and confusion

Jesus woke us that night like a troubled friend who needed someone to talk to. He was unhappy - being kicked out of His Church - and He was firm, He needed our support, our cooperation, our giving, our loyalty, our dying to self. In 2002, I couldn't see what Jesus was referring to in His Church, I could only guess. Now after watching that documentary, I see a little more of how bad, how grave, how dark the Vatican and its leaders really are. Jesus has been kicked out of His Church and the evil one has taken over. The frog is being cooked slowly and doesn't realize it. The deception and confusion is so apparent. And we are so blind. And when the current pope comes out with statements like "who am I to judge?" - isn't that sending even more confusing signals down the line? Not to mention the questionnaire he sent out to accumulate the people of the Church's opinion on homosexuality and living in

sin etc.

Interpret

We saw in the February 2014 Newsletter, in an article entitled 'We must wake up out of our complacency,' one example of how priests can interpret what this pope has said on making bad choices in life: the priest offered two people living in sin 'A marriage by the pope' so they could go to Holy Communion!

Prayer and sacrifice

Last night when I watched that documentary, I knew only prayer and sacrifice given to Jesus could fix the problem. I see the great, great need to get it right for Jesus, to be His Light, His Remnant, His Spark, His Army... I really don't think the Father is going to delay Jesus in Coming back for much longer because this world is growing darker each day. No one seems to know what a sin is anymore. Everything gets justified away.

When we look at the shocking pictures of the aborted babies, it drives and spurs us on to do more in the fight against abortion - let's use these scandals in the same way!

Song of the Carpenter

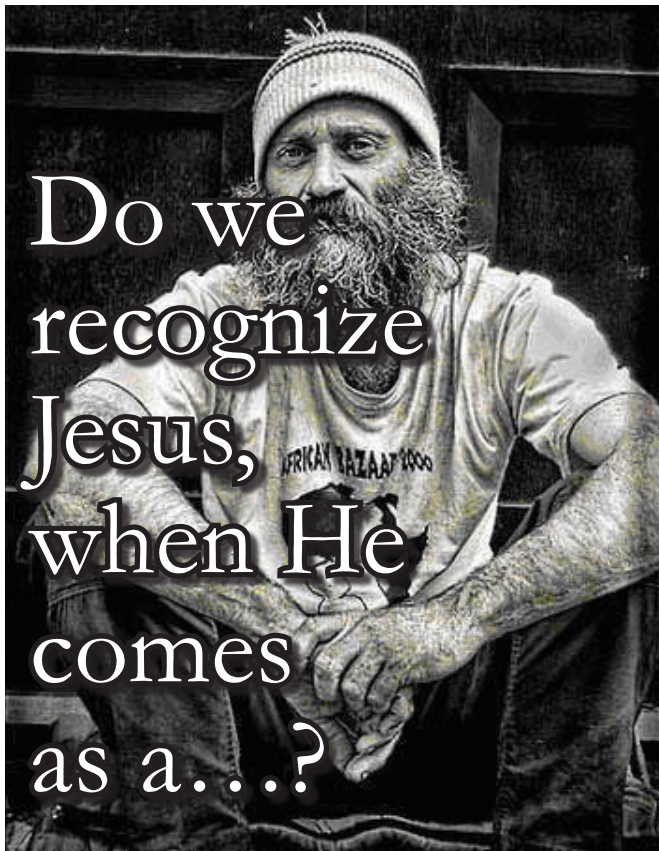
Jesus used the image of "the old man, shaking in his age and love" - whom I believe to be Pope John Paul II - to help Him make His Sacrifice, as we read in this extract from Song of the Carpenter:

...Before him (*Jesus*) he saw

a great domed building, rich in history and glory, rich in a faded love, jaded, tired from the effort. Patterns of its survival had weaved its walls; stone after stone laced and mortared with blood, sacrifice, effort and prayer. Its spirit sagged, wilted under the force of human greed and ambition. Its corridors sang with footfalls and the song rang untruth and mockery of the martyrdoms that had built it. Men like carrion maggots crawled through it with their intelligence and ate the truth in great mouthfuls with their mandibles, destroying its potency, destroying what he had given here, what he would give. Great furrows of disobedience raked its walls and darkness, not light, shone through the gashes, the dust motes of unbelief, unseen, unheard. He could smell the stench of the enemy, mincing his way to the throne, fawned along by courtiers dressed in red and black, male and female, filled with the lust that was now allowed into the sanctuary of their vocation, the murder that filled the air with silent, wailing screams, unheard, not looked for; the air filled with the heady stench of praise songs for him. The praise songs for the enemy's spirits of the four directions, long conquered by him and now resurrected and given life in the very sanctuary that he was building with his own blood, his suffering. Now, in this rock place, the

sorrow, the suffering, the pure giving, the salvation would be handed over to the one who had beat him. It would be given by the very people that he would die for. He saw a handful of souls, bathed in light and fighting still for what he had wrought. One was an old man who was the threads that bound them together in obedience, held up the sagging beams of truth. A cup of poison was being pressed to Jesus' lips, burning, the first of many, and the voice that rang out, reverberated within him, echoing through body and soul, "Will you still do it? Will you still give it all for the sake of a handful? Will you die in their stead and take on all the dirt that they can throw at you with their sins?" His mind screamed, his soul screamed, his heart screamed in agony, pain, giving, love, he did not know what it was now, but it betrayed everything that was human in him, and the old man, shaking in his age and love, was before him, tugging and wrenching at his heart, "I will..." he shouted, "I will..." Jesus collapsed and went still as the sound of his voice echoed through the vast, empty wilderness. No one heard him, no one was allowed to hear him this night, except his Father. His Father wept...

So let's make every effort now to give our lives to Jesus in sacrifice as the clock is ticking!

Transformed himself

Pastor Jeremiah Steepok (pictured above) transformed himself into a homeless person and went to the ten thousand member church that he was to be introduced as the head pastor at that morning. He walked around his soon to be church for thirty minutes while it was filling with people for service, only three people out of the seven to ten thousand people said hello to him. He asked people for change to buy food - NO ONE in the church gave him change. He went into the sanctuary

to sit down in the front of the church and was asked by the ushers if he would please sit in the back. He greeted people to be greeted back with stares and dirty looks, with people looking down on him and judging him.

The homeless man

As he sat in the back of the church, he listened to the church announcements and such. When all that was done, the elders went up and were excited to introduce the new pastor of the church to the congregation. "We would like to introduce to you Pastor Jeremiah Steepok."

Take your inheritance

The congregation looked around clapping with joy and anticipation. The homeless man sitting in the back stood up and started walking down the aisle. The clapping stopped with ALL eyes on him. He walked up to the altar and took the microphone from the elders (who were in on this) and paused for a moment then he recited:

"Then the King will say to those on His right, 'Come, you who are blessed by My Father; take your inheritance, the Kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world. For I was hungry and you gave Me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave Me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited Me in, I needed clothes and you clothed Me, I was sick and you looked after Me, I was in prison and you came to visit Me.'"
"Then the righteous will answer Him, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry and feed You, or thirsty and give You something to drink? When did we see You a stranger and invite You in, or needing clothes and clothe You? When did we see You sick or in prison and go to visit You?'"

'The King will reply, 'Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of Mine, you did for Me.'

Not enough disciples

After he recited this, he looked towards the

congregation and told them all what he had experienced that morning. Many began to cry and many heads were bowed in shame. He then said, "Today I see a gathering of people, not a church of Jesus Christ. The

world has enough people, but not enough disciples. When will YOU decide to become disciples?" He then dismissed service until next week. Being a Christian is more than something you claim.

Transformation

Contemplative Prayer



Time to radically change

We all know the importance of prayer in our lives, as an individual, family prayer, community prayer. We all pray for a happy death as we believe that someday we will stand before our Maker. Yes, all humans, regardless of wealth or status, will stand alone before our Maker, our God, to answer for our sins. No one will escape, all must go before the Lord for Judgment. We

do not like to think of this appointment with God. For some, it could be a long way off – for others in the blink of an eye - you might not even get time to finish this article!! The time to radically change is now! To prepare ourselves to stand alone, Face to face, with our Great God. We can't hide from Gods judgement so why wait until death? Surely it makes sense to prepare now and we can do this through contemplative prayer.

'Contemplative Prayer'

When we pray we communicate with God, but do we give God time and silence to communicate with us? I am a great believer in prayer and for most of my life enjoyed well known prayers: Rosaries and Novenas. Now, as a servant within the House of Prayer, I have been introduced to 'Contemplative Prayer' a very helpful and powerful prayer.

What is

Contemplative Prayer?

It is finding the Present Moment, finding Jesus here and now. It is prayer without images, words, beads etc. Without concentrating on holy thoughts etc. How do we pray this way? We sit in silence, bringing ourselves wordlessly before God, as we will when we die; to be judged by God. Sitting in the Presence of the Lord and listening for His Voice within our hearts. Contemplative prayer is prayer without words. I

found this quite difficult at first. I felt I should be doing all the talking – through prayers. For years I went to Adoration with beads and prayer books – something to read to pass the time! I was taught by the nuns that idle hands and heads made work for the devil, so I found it quite strange to sit exposed before God without my support of prayer books and beads!

His Holy Presence

Now I find a quiet place, in the House of Prayer Prayer Room, the chapel or a room within my home and I make a conscious act to place myself before God and be silent. I sit alone with Jesus. No

need for words, thoughts, no images to distract me. Contemplative prayer brings me into Gods Presence. I cannot feel His Presence - yet - but I believe firmly that I am within His holy Presence. Nowhere to run, nowhere to hide, just Jesus and me, like it will be when I die and come Face to face with Him.

Enjoy the silence

I sit relaxed and enjoy the silence with my God. I feel exposed; almost guilty for not saying prayers or reading Scripture. I am conscious of the beat of my

heart, giving silently every heartbeat as an act of love to my Lord and my God. Our world is full of voices and distractions. Taking an hour out to sit in silence with our Lord is precious. He knows all about us; our fears, wants and needs. We do not need to remind Him! The silence gives Jesus a chance to talk to us within our hearts – gives us a chance to listen to Him, prepares us to stand in silence, Face to face with



Him when our earthly body dies.

Give an hour to Jesus

It is difficult at first to practice 'Contemplative Prayer' but practice makes perfect. I am getting better at sitting before the Lord in silence and hopefully soon I will be able to keep the full hour without being distracted! I feel refreshed, relaxed and get encouraged after my hour with Jesus, it is as if I am giving my brain cells a rest and my heart and soul fully to Jesus. Try contemplative prayer; give an hour to Jesus.

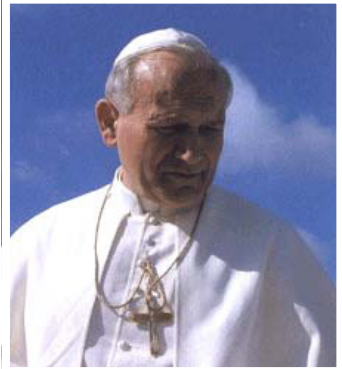

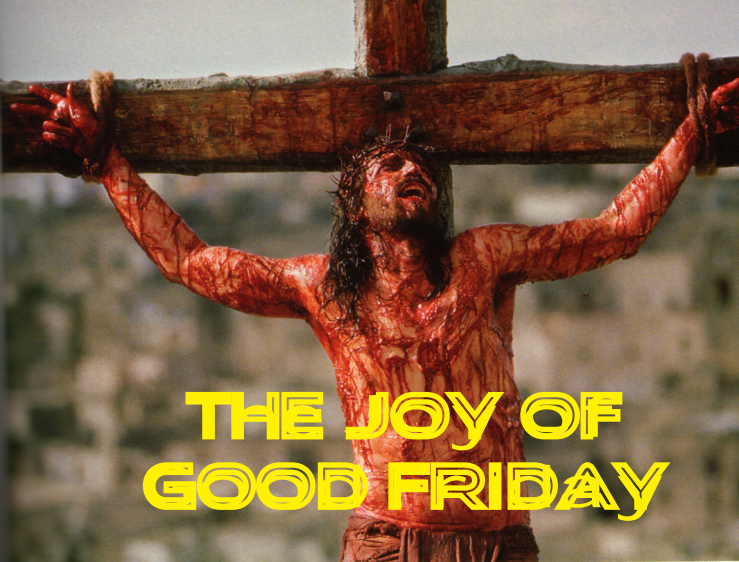
Some interesting facts about Pope John Paul II our 'Pilgrim Pope'



There is much joy around the world at the canonization of Pope John Paul II. He is very much loved by everyone and truly deserves the title of 'Saint' and in our opinion he lived as a saint. We have included here a few things he achieved in his pontificate.

- Pope John Paul served twenty six years as pontiff.
- He was the longest serving Pope of the twentieth century.
- Pope John Paul wrote many books that were published during his papacy, including: "Crossing the Threshold of Hope" in 1994; "Gift and Mystery," an account of his early priesthood, in 1996; "Roman Tryptych - Meditations," a book of poems, in 2003; "Rise, Let Us Be on Our Way," which focuses on his years in Krakow, in 2004; and "Memory and Identity" in 2005.
- He also wrote: fourteen Encyclicals, fifteen Apostolic Exhortations, eleven Apostolic Constitutions, forty five Apostolic Letters
- Pope John Paul made nine trips to his native Poland as pontiff. The first was in 1979, the last in 2002.
- During his papacy, he made one hundred and four foreign trips, far more than any other pope.
- He declared four hundred and eighty two saints during his papacy - more than the number declared by all the popes in the last five hundred years combined.
- Pope John Paul II beatified one thousand three hundred and thirty eight people during his papacy.
- The Vatican estimates that 17,647,800 people have taken part in John Paul II's weekly general audiences in Saint Peter's Square.
- He established World Youth Days and celebrated nineteen of them.
- He made Thérèse of the Child Jesus a Doctor of the Church .
- He added the Luminous Mysteries to the Rosary.
- As the Bishop of Rome, he visited almost one hundred and twenty nine countries, including Mexico, Cuba, Ireland, United Kingdom, Egypt and Jerusalem and was later, given the name 'Pilgrim Pope' for his extensive travels.

Pope John Paul II left us the Truth of the Church in the many writings he did. The Truth is very much under attack in the world and Church today but all the Sacred Truths are kept safe in his books and letters. They are there to guide us through these times of darkness.



THE JOY OF GOOD FRIDAY

Pregnant

Six years ago I was pregnant with my second child. I already had a young son and was looking forward to having another baby. On the Thursday before Holy Week, I went to the hospital for the usual scan and it never occurred to me that there would or could be anything wrong.

Something wrong

When the sonographer scanned me, she put the scan photo into an envelope and drew a red circle on it. I was shown to a room where a midwife came to talk to me and my husband. Still it never occurred to me that there was something wrong.

Unable to find a heartbeat

The midwife told me that they had been unable to find a heartbeat and the baby had actually died several weeks ago. They could tell this because the gestational age of the baby was only seven weeks and

the placenta's age was about nine and a half weeks while I was close to thirteen weeks pregnant.

I remember being totally shocked. I had no idea there was anything wrong. Everything had seemed normal to me and I had not bled or anything as you would expect if the baby was dead. I felt cold and shocked.

Decided to do

Because the baby had not come away itself, I was given several options. I could either have a D&C¹, take pessaries to force the cervix open so that the baby would come away or I could do nothing and just wait for the baby to come away itself.

I was sent home to think about it over the weekend and was told to come in on the Monday of Holy Week. I would be rescanned on this day to make sure that what they had said was right and to tell them what I had

decided to do.

Hope drained from me

I returned on that Monday and, while they were scanning me, I was aware how much I had hoped that they were wrong and, as I looked at the screen, I was desperate to see the heartbeat. But I did not. And I was devastated. All hope drained from me. The baby was dead and I had a decision to make.

Waiting

I could not face a D&C because it reminded me so much of abortion; nor could I bear the thought of carrying a dead baby inside me and just waiting until it came away itself. The baby had already been dead for several weeks and I just didn't think I could carry on for another few weeks with the knowledge I now had. So I opted for the pessaries. Now I had to go home and wait. It was an awful few days and I had to return to get more pessaries because my cervix was not opening. To my mind, it was like my body would not accept that the baby was no more.

Eireann

However, very soon after my second dose, I had contractions and my body expelled the entire pregnancy sack with the baby inside. This in itself was a Grace because I was able to put the baby into a tiny coffin. We had a little church service in a small local chapel and buried our baby on Good Friday. I

believe this baby was a girl and we called her Eireann. I remember that this was a very traumatic time for me. I didn't attend any of the church services for Holy Thursday, Good Friday or Holy Saturday. However, I did get out of bed and go to Mass on Easter Sunday.

I was at Mass

I was at Mass and everything was halleluiah this and halleluiah that. While sitting in the pew, I looked to Jesus and said to Him, "Jesus, I know You are happy. I know You Suffered greatly on Good Friday and today is Your Day of Joy and I'm sorry but I just don't feel joyful... And in an instant I heard Jesus saying to me, 'But you should feel joy. You should feel joy because, because of what I did on Good Friday, your daughter is able to be with Me.' And I saw an image of Jesus holding a young girl on His Arm. She had long red hair and was so happy and Jesus was smiling!

Easter Joy

In that moment, all my grief left me and I felt the Easter joy. I was happy, she was happy and Jesus was happy! From that moment I never looked back. I was content and happy to let her go to God. I can honestly say I never felt a moment of grief from that day on, nor do I miss her.

Jesus said it in this Message: ...Look, children, with wonder and see not Death but Life for it was upon this Day that you

were born into My Father's Kingdom. Rejoice, children, rejoice in My Love for you have been Redeemed...
(From the thirteenth Station of the Cross given by Jesus to the two Patricks)

I will see her some day

I do think about Eireann every Good Friday and Easter Sunday but not in a grieving way. I know I will see her some day and I am quite content to wait until then.

There is a song that says it all:

With Jesus I can overcome



¹ (D&C, also known as dilation and curettage, is a surgical procedure often performed after a first trimester miscarriage. Dilation means to open up the cervix; curettage means to remove the contents of the uterus. Curettage may be performed by scraping the uterine wall with a curette instrument or by a suction curettage (also called vacuum aspiration), using a vacuum-type instrument.)

FEAST OF THE ANNUNCIATION Tuesday 25 March

The Annunciation was celebrated in the House of Prayer on 25 March as an

International Twenty Four Hour Day of Prayer and Fasting Against Abortion. There was a great peace and haven which surrounded this Day in particular and all those present felt it. Everyone was relaxed and happy because of this. There was a great hunger and want to be with Jesus in His Prayer Room on this Day for there was up to three people present in the Prayer Room each hour from 12am to 12 midnight.

Mary, Patron of the Aborted

Community Prayers took place at 12, 3pm and 6pm - these included the Rosary and Baptism of the Unborn. At all 12 noon and 3pm prayers, a servant would give a talk but on this Day the talks were more than significant, they were powerful and informative. The servant who spoke at 12 noon spoke how this day - what it stood for - how the image of 'Mary, Patron of the Aborted' came about and its powerful meaning that can somewhat be forgotten and also how this Day of Prayer and Fasting

Prayers at 6pm included a Special Baptism of the Unborn where we also light a candle for the baptised. SonLight Music Ministry also played a few songs including the one we sing whilst on abortion walks 'Never Felt The Wind.' This was a beautiful way to end Community Prayers for the Day.

EASTER RETREAT Thursday 17 April to Sunday 20 April

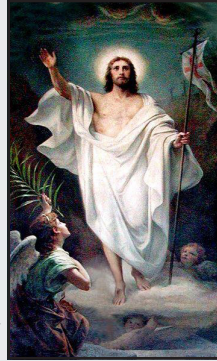
Holy Saturday

Recent surveys

From the recent surveys people were asked to complete about their views on Catholic teachings there have been some disastrous results. What are these surveys for? Are the teachings going to change because of the peoples' views? If they do, it will become a human church where Gods Laws do not count or are not taken into consideration.

Condoning adultery

Because of these results, some clergy in Germany have suggested allowing divorced remarried Catholics to receive Holy Communion. However, is this not condoning adultery? Jesus said if a man divorces his wife and marries another he commits adultery. Adultery is a mortal sin! So then its ok to commit mortal sin and receive Jesus in Holy Communion? Do you think Jesus would be happy with this? He does not go against the Commandments

or change them in any way. Gods Laws are the same today, yesterday and forever!

Like an angry pack of dogs

On 26 April 2010, Jesus said:

"...The times are dark now as the destruction of My Church



continues from within and without.

Look, My children, as they pull it apart like an angry pack of dogs. This has been their plan and they have placed the deceivers within My Church in order to fulfil what they have planned for many years. Their father is pleased with what they have done and believes that he can destroy Me in his blindness..."

A sober inventory

Father Shenan Boquet, president of an International Pro-Life organisation, wrote about two recent surveys and this was reported in lifesitenews on 14 March: The first survey is from

the well-respected Pew Research Centre, revealing that seventy seven percent of U.S. Catholics polled believe the Catholic Church should allow its members to use birth control and that a majority believe the Church should allow its priests to marry (seventy two percent) and want to ordain women as priests (sixty eight percent). The second was released by the German Bishops' Conference, its data reflecting a response to a Vatican survey in preparation for the Synod on the Family in October. Though the survey revealed that German Catholics accepted and respected the Church's teaching on stable marriages and family life, it also revealed an overwhelming rejection of the Church's teaching on pre-marital relations, cohabitation, homosexuality and Communion for those who are remarried after divorce. According to the survey, Germans found the Church's teaching on sexual morality "unrealistic and heartless." The bishops called the results "a sober inventory of what German Catholics appreciate about Church teaching on marriage and the family and what they find off-putting or unacceptable, either mostly or completely."

Comfortable in their sin

Fr Boquet also commented: But also troubling is that we are now hearing calls even from within the Church to

conform the "pastoral practice" of the Church to this confusion and desolation. As if it is the Church's role to make those who are truly lost feel more comfortable in their sin and error, rather than offering them a voice of love in truth, calling them back to God and His Plan for their true happiness.

Wolves in sheep's clothing

Jesus said in one of the latest Messages of Love, 16 March 2014:

"...Follow Me in Truth and do not deviate from My Path that I have set down within My Gospels. More and more deceit, lies, pour from the mouths of those who say they are My shepherds; they are controlled by lucifer, they are wolves in sheep's clothing and they are the ones that devastate My flock..."

Support the "gay marriage"

In London, on 2 April 2014, lifesitenews reported that the Catholic Bishops' Conference of England and Wales had assured Catholic Members of Parliament that there were "no plans" to refuse them Holy Communion after they



voted to support the "gay marriage" legislation that came into effect recently. However, the Bishop of Portsmouth, Philip Egan, in a recent interview with lifesitenews said that denying Communion to someone engaged publicly in grave sin is an "act of mercy" and a "medicinal" remedy for Catholics.

Shouldn't be receiving Holy Communion

He also said, "When people are not in communion with the Catholic Church on such a central thing as the value of life of the unborn child and also in terms of the teachings of the Church on marriage and family life – they are voting in favour of same-sex marriage – then they shouldn't be receiving Holy Communion." Bishop Egan refused to

be intimidated by the possibility of opposition, saying "Nobody is forced to be Catholic."

"We're called by Christ and He's chosen us, it's a free choice. We live under the Word of God. It's not my truth, it's God's Truth. One would hope that in that case it would encourage someone to come back to seek communion with the Lord, with the Truth and say I'm sorry, I got lost."

Persevering in manifest grave sin

Bishop Egan's comments were a reiteration of Canon 915 of the Church's Code of Canon Law, which says, "Those who have been excommunicated or interdicted after the imposition or declaration of the penalty and others obstinately persevering in manifest grave sin are not to be admitted to Holy Communion."

Pastoral charity

In the dissident Catholic

Tablet magazine, Burns castigated Bishop Egan for failing to get with the Pope Francis program: "I think it is a great pity, indeed a tragedy, that this bishop appears not to have noticed that we have a new gentle shepherd preaching a Christ-like message of inclusivity, love, tolerance and forgiveness. I look to the guidance of the holy father, pope Francis."!!

Egan's statements reflect those of American Cardinal Raymond Burke who recently called a priest's refusal to give Holy Communion to a publicly dissenting Catholic politician a "prime act of pastoral charity," since it helps the person in question to "avoid sacrilege and safeguard[s] the other faithful from scandal."

Brought to desolation

But a few Catholic MPs who support legal abortion and same-sex "marriage" called Egan's statements "a tragedy," saying that

ordinary Catholics would be "appalled," reported The Tablet.

As Jesus said in Scripture: 17 But He seeing their thoughts, said to them: Every kingdom divided against itself, shall be brought to desolation and house upon house shall fall...

23 He that is not with Me, is against Me and he that gathereth not with Me, scattereth.

Luke 11:17-23

Redemption is near at hand!

Jesus has promised to be with us to the end of time. He promised that the gates of hell would not prevail against His Church. There are still many good shepherds in the Church that are holding on to the true teachings of the Catholic faith. They need our prayers and support. 52. The Jews therefore quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this Man give us His flesh to eat?"

53. Then Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh

of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you.

So many of us have been accustomed to the self of this world. We forget so easily that we are here to do the Will of our Father in Heaven and not our own. We walk around with blindfolds on ignoring the sin in our lives and accepting pretty much anything. We forget our main purpose is to love one another and reflect on where we want to spend

Eternal Life. This life matters so little yet it means so much to us. Jesus says the body matters so little, it's the soul that counts.

54. Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life and I will raise him up at the last day.

We are extremely Blessed as Catholics to have the great



Gift of the Holy Eucharist. This is the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus. Do we realise when we receive Him what we are actually taking? If we believed in Jesus, in His Power, receiving Holy

Communion should make us Saints, miracle workers, healers, in other words, just like Jesus.

Child labourers in sweat shops

The rights of a person

'Human life must be respected and protected absolutely from the moment of conception. From the first moment of his existence, a human being must be recognised as having the rights of a person - among which is the inviolable right of every innocent being to life (*Catechism of the Catholic Church, 2270*)



The world is a dangerous place for children. Even the womb, designed to be a place of nurturing sanctity, can be a violent and fatal place.

Ten hour days

The past ten years have seen some admissions from multinational companies regarding their cost cutting measures and the use of child labour in order to maximise

their already enormous profit margins.

In 1999, Marks and Spencer who were proud to boast of being a British company, were accused by Indonesian

workers of selling clothes made by child labourers. These children were working ten hour days for less than fifty pence in Jakarta.

The companies

Marks and Spencer are not alone. The following are just a few of the companies named as using child labour;

- Mc Donalds
- Coca Cola
- Nestle
- Adidas
- Gap
- Nike
- Walmart
- Firestone
- Disney
- Victorias Secret
- Abercrombie & Fitch
- Primark
- Apple

The greed for profit is insatiable. What level would these companies stoop to in order to gain wealth? The question that scares me though is: do I care? Will I still buy from these companies knowing what they are doing?

Forced to work overtime

Philip Morris, a tobacco company based in America, admitted to using seventy two child slaves. They only admitted this when they were forced to by human rights watch. The youngest were ten years old and were found with rashes on their stomachs and necks. Their passports were confiscated, enslaving them. They were forced to work overtime for no extra pay. The scariest part is that the company have not lived up to their promise of changing the situation.

We are all guilty

On 10 October 1999, Jesus said: My children, in these Words I remind you once again, that it is your duty to love one another without exception. Your main effort is love. I have called many to go forth into this world and spread love.

We are all guilty of being lovers of pleasure of some form as Jesus spoke of in the Gospels. Would we be happy though to buy goods we knew were being made in factories by tortured children? Children who are housed in dorms of fourteen, given a bucket and sponge

instead of a shower and work fifteen hour shifts with no weekend breaks. They are not allowed to speak to each other and women are subjected to sexual harassment.

Attacked

Nike have unashamedly used child labour for years. When they withdrew their orders from a factory in Indonesia, they left seven thousand workers jobless. When they took their orders to another factory in China, they failed to offer employees any severance pay. When workers protested over pay at their factory in Cambodia, twenty three women were injured, one unfortunately miscarried when attacked.

Our greed

Is it our greed? Has our lack of love for fellow man caused the need for this mass production and exploitation? Why should half the world suffer so that we can have nice exercise clothes and shoes? All so that we can shift excess weight we carry from over eating while our brothers and sisters across the world

starve to death!

We can blame the wealthy, the governments but we all have a part to play. Companies justify their behaviour by saying; if we don't use these workers, where will they end up? My question to them is: if you paid them well and treat them well, where would they end up?

Something beautiful

By giving up our desires and greed for the things of this world and offering the sacrifice to Jesus, He can use this to comfort His people. Jesus can take even the smallest of our sacrifices and turn them into something beautiful, turning the tide on this greed and lack of love.

We all love a bargain. But remember, if something seems very cheap, there is often a reason for that and a price has been paid by someone else. Consider using local suppliers, or better still, charity shops. Please remember these exploited children in your prayers.



The Wisdom of John Paul II

On the Christian Family in the Modern World Apostolic Exhortation of His Holiness, Pope John Paul II *Continued*

47. The social role that belongs to every family pertains by a new and original right to the Christian family, which is based on the sacrament of marriage. By taking up the human reality of the love between husband and wife in all its implications, the sacrament gives to Christian couples and parents a power and a commitment to live their vocation as lay people and therefore to “seek the kingdom of God by engaging in temporal affairs and by ordering them according to the plan of God.”

The social and political role is included in the kingly mission of service in which Christian couples share by virtue of the sacrament of marriage, and they receive both a command which they cannot ignore and a grace which sustains and stimulates them.

The Christian family is thus called upon to offer everyone a witness of generous and disinterested dedication to social matters through a “preferential option” for the poor and disadvantaged. Therefore, advancing in

its following of the Lord by special love for all the poor, it must have special concern for the hungry, the poor, the old, the sick, drug victims and those who have no family.

48. In view of the worldwide dimension of various social questions nowadays, the family has seen its role with regard to the development of society extended in a completely new way: It now also involves cooperating for a new international order, since it is only in worldwide solidarity that the enormous and dramatic issues of world justice, the freedom of peoples and the peace of humanity can be dealt with and solved.

The spiritual communion between Christian families, rooted in a common faith and hope and given life by love, constitutes an inner energy that generates, spreads and develops justice, reconciliation, fraternity and peace among human beings. Insofar as it is a “small-scale church,” the Christian family is called upon, like the “large-scale church,” to be a sign of unity for the world and in this way to exercise its prophetic role by bearing witness to the kingdom and peace of Christ, toward which the whole world is journeying.

Christian families can do this through their educational activity - that is to say, by presenting to their children a model of life based on the values of truth, freedom, justice and love - both through active and responsible involvement in the authentically human growth of society and its institutions, and supporting in various ways the associations specifically devoted to international issues.

IV. SHARING IN THE LIFE AND MISSION OF THE CHURCH

49. Among the fundamental tasks of the Christian family is its ecclesial task: The family is placed at the service of the building up of the kingdom of God in history by participating in the life and mission of the church.

In order to understand better the foundations, the contents and the characteristics of this participation, we must examine the many profound bonds linking the church and the Christian family and establishing the family as a “church in miniature” (*ecclesia domestica*), in such a way that in its own way the family is a living image and historical representation of the mystery of the church. It is, above all, the church as mother that gives birth to,

educates and builds up the Christian family by putting into effect in its regard the saving mission which she has received from her Lord. By proclaiming the word of God the church reveals to the Christian family its true identity, what it is and should be according to the Lord's plan; by celebrating the sacraments the church enriches and strengthens the Christian family with the grace of Christ for its sanctification to the glory of the Father; by the continuous proclamation of the new commandment of love the church encourages and guides the Christian family to the service of love so that it may imitate and relive the same self-giving and sacrificial love that the Lord Jesus has for the entire human race.

In turn, the Christian family is grafted into the mystery of the church to such a degree as to become a sharer, in its own way, in the saving mission proper to the church: By virtue of the sacrament Christian married couples and parents "in their state and way of life have their own special gift among the people of God." For this reason they not only receive the love of Christ and become a saved community, but they are also called upon to communicate Christ's love to their brethren thus becoming a saving community. In this way, while the Christian family is a fruit and sign of the supernatural fecundity

of the church, it stands also as a symbol, witness and participant of the church's motherhood.

50. The Christian family is called upon to take part actively and responsibly in the mission of the church in a way that is original and specific by placing itself in what it is and what it does as an "intimate community of life and love" at the service of the church and of society.

Since the Christian family is a community in which the relationships are renewed by Christ through faith and the sacraments, the family's sharing in the church's mission should follow a community pattern: The spouses together as a couple, the parents and children as a family, must live their service to the church and to the world. They must be "of one heart and soul" in faith, through the shared apostolic zeal that animates them and through their shared commitment to works of service in the ecclesial and civil communities.

The Christian family also builds up the kingdom of God in history through the everyday realities that concern and distinguish its state of life. It is thus in the love between husband and wife and between the members of the family - a love lived out in all its extraordinary richness of values and demands: totality, oneness, fidelity and fruitfulness" - that the Christian family's

participation in the prophetic, priestly and kingly mission of Jesus Christ and of his church finds expression and realization. Therefore, love and life constitute the nucleus of the saving mission of the Christian family in the church and for the church. The Second Vatican Council recalls this fact when it writes: "Families will share their spiritual riches generously with other families too. Thus the Christian family, which springs from marriage as a reflection of the loving covenant uniting Christ with the church, and as a participation in that covenant will manifest to all people the savior's living presence in the world, and the genuine nature of the church. This the family will do by the mutual love of the spouses, by their generous fruitfulness, their solidarity and faithfulness, and by the loving way in which all the members of the family work together."

Having laid the foundation of the participation of the christian family in the church's mission, it is now time to illustrate its substance in reference to Jesus Christ as prophet, priest and king - three aspects of a single reality - by presenting the Christian family as 1) a believing and evangelizing community, 2) a community in dialogue with God, and 3) a community at the service of man.
