DYING TO SELF

His Will

Fear and trust are the opposites of one another. We say that we fear God but, we must ask ourselves the question: if this is true, why do we not do the things that He asks of us?

Fulfilled

This is a very significant piece of Scripture for these times and most of us choose to blind ourselves to the reality of what is happening in the world and especially within the Church. What is the Eighth Amendment?

What is the Eighth Amendment & the background to it?

Abortion had been outlawed in Ireland under sections 58 and 59 of the Offences against the body act, 1861. In 1973, in the case of *McGee vs Attorney General*, the Irish Supreme Court ruled against provisions of the Criminal Law Amendment Act 1935 prohibiting the sale and importation of contraception on the grounds that the reference in Article 41 to the "imprescriptable rights, antecedent and superior to all positive law" of the family conferred upon spouses a broad right to privacy in marital affairs. This was the same year as the *Roe vs Wade* case in the USA, where the Supreme Court of the United States ruled under similar grounds of a right to abortion grounded on privacy. It was now feared that under similar grounds,

abortion could possibly be legalised in Ireland. In 1981, the Pro-Life Amendment Campaign was established to urge the Government to introduce a bill to allow an amendment to the constitution which would prevent the Irish Supreme Court the constitution as was to allow for abortion.

Eighth time

The following wording was proposed and put before the people in a referendum in 1983:

"The State acknowledges the right to life of the unborn and, with due regard to the equal right to life of the mother, guarantees in its laws to respect and, as far as practicable, by its laws to defend and vindicate that right."

This was passed by a 67-33% majority and Article 40.3.3 of the Constitution, otherwise known as the Eighth Amendment (as

it was the eighth time the Irish Constitution was amended) came into being.

What does the Eighth Amendment provide or prevent?

Abortion in Ireland is illegal unless it spontaneously occurs as the result of a medical intervention performed to save the life of the mother, ie the non-intentional taking of the life of the baby (causing a miscarriage or resulting in a stillborn baby) due to necessary medical procedures. The law means that where practicable, both the mother and baby are considered equally when it comes to medical matters.

Startling facts about Abortion rates: Do we want to follow suit in Ireland?

In 2014, one in two pregnancies in Greenland ends in abortion!

In Russia, 44% of all pregnancies end in abortion! In USA it is 22%, 21% in the UK and 20% in Australia (that is approximately one in every five pregnancies in these countries and two in five for Russia!!!!!!!!!!!!!!)

190,000 abortions took place in England and Wales in 2014. That is the population of Cork City here in Ireland or the number killed when the atomic bomb was dropped on Hiroshima!

One in three women in the UK will have an abortion in their lifetime according to the NHS website.

90% of suspected cases of Downs Syndrome in the UK ends in abortion. In Iceland, the latest figures were 100%! Denmark's current figure is 98% with a state plan to "eradicate" Downs Syndrome from the country by 2030!



Ireland's Eighth Amendment

three years ago, sixty seven percent of the population voted for the Eighth Amendment.

'Repeal'

Today, sadly, many are calling for a referendum on the Eighth Amendment. They want abortion made legal in Ireland. As the law stands, abortion is illegal and can carry a sentence of fourteen years imprisonment. In September of last year (2015), a campaign for the 'repeal' of Article 40.3.3 (Eighth

Sixty seven percent

The Eighth Amendment of the Constitution of Ireland introduced a constitutional ban on abortion in 1983 by recognising the 'Right to Life' of an unborn child. Thirty

Amendment) was launched, after a woman was refused an abortion under the current law.

Thou shall not kill

What about Gods Law? Gods Commandment 'Thou shalt not kill?' Abortion is the brutal murder of an innocent child within its mother's womb. If this was being done to animals, people would be outraged and would campaign to have it stopped. A pregnancy is two people of Gods creation, living under the same skin. The unborn, as the most vulnerable, must be protected and granted its right to life.

On 11 August 1995, Jesus said:

"...I need you to come to Me for behind your backs they bring abortion into your homes... Do not abandon Ireland to this evil... I need you to stand up and fight now..."

Jesus called for us to pray much for the great sin of abortion:

"...Pray much for My children in this country...and for the great sin of abortion..."

The Eighth Amendment

Here in Ireland, there is a huge push at present to abolish the Eighth Amendment and, essentially, to bring in abortion on demand! The Eighth Amendment is a law that protects both mother and baby during a pregnancy.

Up until recent years, the pro-abortion lobby wasn't incredibly strong or popular here in Ireland.

Let's Stand Together

While they would show up at the Pro-Life rallies giving out, it was in much smaller numbers compared to the Pro-Life side, thank God! However, something has changed and people have become more blinded by the lies that abortion is acceptable, that it's a human right and that women deserve to be able to have an abortion! Cool and hipster

There were several videos released recently by the pro-abortion lobby promoting their convoluted ideology, why they think abortion should be legislated. They are desperately trying to make abortion look cool and hipster, by having artists contribute to it. One video called 'We Face this Land' is very dark and eerie, women chant

together that they are the witches that haven't been drowned as they walk into the sea, dressed in their black 'REPEAL' jumpers. The video itself is very strange in many ways. It is very critical of the Church. It also makes statements such as comparing a woman's body to that of cattle. I've noticed quite a few people walking about wearing these jumpers. Again I don't think most people know what abortion actually is or, what it does to innocent babies who are still in the womb, not to mention their mothers, fathers and other family members.

I pray to Jesus

Another big pro-choice push is coming from Amnesty International, the so called 'Human Rights' organisation. They go out on the streets in the cities here in Ireland quite regularly, campaigning and collecting money to promote this 'reproductive right', when really they should be looking at what their organisation says about human torture! When I see them, I pray to Jesus, 'Forgive them, Father, for they know not what they do!'

We even see that now Carphone Warehouse, one of the largest UK smartphone dealers has, unashamedly, started to promote pro-choice. They have huge banners all about the place 'down south' advertising this fact.

Freedom of choice

In Waterford, a big mural was painted on a wall overlooking the city stating 'Repeal.' It has recently been turned into 'Reveal' promoting mental health awareness, instead of promoting abortion. They are also

using this year, 2016, the hundredth anniversary of the 1916 Rising and birth of the Republic of Ireland, as a ploy to promote this so called 'freedom of choice.'

Imagine

There was a march held in Dublin this September: 'Rise and Repeal' was their motto. They had posters and banners all around the big cities advertising this event and the free buses were provided for anyone who wished to go along. Their Facebook page read as follows;

...Imagine you are a young girl in a foreign country. You have been raped and are now pregnant. You have no money. You have no options. You ask for help to get an abortion. You can't have any help

...Imagine your daughter has [a] massive brain trauma and has been pronounced clinically dead by the medical team in the hospital. However you are not able to start grieving. She was 17 weeks pregnant as she is being kept alive because the foetus is still alive. None of your family want this to happen.....

...Imagine that you are pregnant and excitedly expecting your first child. You go in for your 21 weeks scan and suddenly there's a problem. Your baby isn't well, she will not survive outside of the womb....

..Imagine that contraception fails. Imagine that not all pregnancies are wanted. Imagine that over 73,000 Irish women had travelled to the UK alone in the last 15 years to have an abortion and you don't know one of them....

..You are a woman. You live in Ireland. You are denied basic health care. You are denied basic human rights. You are denied choice...

This is a protest. March on Saturday. #repealthe8th

Biased

I have many friends who are at different universities across Ireland and they have been telling me how awfully biased their students' unions are on this issue in particular. The leaflets that are handed out to those in first-year in their "freshers' packs" blatantly support the 'pro-abortion' agenda, ranting on about reproductive rights and giving away free repeal jumpers to any of the students who attended the rally! I have done a little of the door to door approach with the 'Yes to Life Team' after college some weeks and we knocked on the doors of the houses in the neighbourhood inviting them to ask any questions they might have about the Eighth Amendment, what their views were on the issue, if any and if they wanted to share anything else with us about abortion. The idea behind this is to allow people the opportunity to talk about abortion, without the entire stigma that surrounds it, to discuss the problems so that we might be able to find solutions.

This saddened me, because I know when it comes to voting, this young lad in his mid-twenties won't understand what he is actually voting in favour of and will only be doing so because his friends want it.

There was a gallery in Dublin which had a design of the Pro-Life



love heart, "abortion stops a beating heart" changed into the word Repeal, painted onto the wall. This organisation is funded by Irish tax payers and is blatantly and publicly supporting abortion! Ridiculous! As an art student, this disgusts me!

I have a lot of friends at universities, who talk about their student unions being extremely biased on the abortion debate and hold referendums in their colleges and do not give a fair chance to the Pro-Life speakers.

While attending a march against student fees in Dublin, I noticed that there were a lot of socialist groups out, promoting the 'repeal message' and giving out free pro-abortion badges to people. There were about three hundred of us taking part and some of us were very anxious because we know so many students who are for abortion and repealing the Eighth. A lot of us were worried about people approaching us and acting aggressively because of our stance.

Joined together

This didn't stop us, however, and we all joined together and supported each other by uploading photos onto social media and liking and sharing each other's posts. It was amazing and so empowering to see what an impact we could make, by this simple idea, praise God!

I was meeting up with a few friends on campus to take photos together with our jumpers on. As I was walking in, I spotted two strangers who were also wearing the jumpers, we were so happy that we were united by these jumpers and by our Pro-Life views and quickly became friends.

Courage to show the truth.

On that Friday morning, the #SaveThe8th was trending on Twitter which was a massive achievement. It brought so much joy and light into our little country which had been left dull after the

release of the pro-abortion video, several weeks before!
So, thank You, Jesus.
What we need is prayer, sacrifice and the courage to show the truth.

Now more than ever, we need to be activists who fight for Jesus and His little innocent babies. It's a matter of life and death!



More Than Meets The Eye

Foetus and human rights

If you listen to the Irish media, whether from newspapers, online or the state broadcaster, RTE; influential groups such as Amnesty International or the NWC (The National Women's Council of Ireland), or even high profile "stars" such as Hozier, Graham Linehan and Charlene McKenna, there is a near constant bombardment of pro-abortion propaganda being pushed on the people of Ireland to slowly but surely alter their mind on the subject of abortion. mothers and unborn babies on Oct. 1 in a passionate speech against abortion.

Ireland is a battleground nation for

abortion activists, backed by some of the world's richest men. The pro-life country's Eighth Amendment protects the right to life of unborn babies and bans abortions except when the mother's life is in jeopardy; but abortion activists are working hard to repeal it.

Pro-abortion efforts

On Saturday, the Catholic Archbishop urged Irish people to counter the pro-abortion efforts with a "revolution of tenderness," according to the Catholic News Agency. Saturday was the Day of Life, a date the Catholic Church in Ireland sets aside to celebrate the sanctity of life.

"This Amendment is precious and wonderful – it places as the very foundations and substructure of our laws a clear conviction that all human life is worth cherishing," Martin said.

"Demands to quash and abolish this Amendment go against the Good News that the life of every person is sacred and inviolable, irrespective of the stage or state of that life – from the first moment of conception until the moment of natural death," he added.

Few countries left

Ireland is one of the few countries left in Europe that protects unborn babies' right to life. Pro-lifers estimate that the Eighth Amendment, which passed in a national referendum in 1983, has saved approximately 100,000 unborn babies' lives from abortion in Ireland.

Pressured

However, the nation is facing global

pressure from the United Nations and pro-abortion groups, backed by some of the world's richest men, to legalize abortion on demand by repealing the Eighth Amendment. Claiming that abortion is a "human right" for women, abortion activists at the UN pressured Ireland in May to legalize the killing of unborn babies in cases of rape, incest, serious risk to the mother's health and fatal fetal abnormalities.

A compassionate measure

Archbishop Martin responded to these claims on Saturday, describing the Eighth Amendment as a compassionate measure that extends love and protections to both women and children.

"It is therefore fundamentally a declaration of tenderness and love for the equal right to life of both a mother and her unborn child. It is an undertaking to respect, defend and vindicate that right here in Ireland," he said.

The same rights

"Nowadays the way of tenderness is indeed counter-cultural and revolutionary," he continued. "It is perhaps the only way to confront inhumanity and cruelty, to bridge the great divide which greed has created between the rich and the poor, and to expose the pervasive 'throwaway culture' which surrounds us."

In August, Ireland's High Court agreed. A High Court judge ruled that the word "unborn" in the Irish Constitution means an "unborn child" who has the same rights as other human beings that "must be taken seriously."

Our Duty to fight

Works of Mercy

Jesus has asked us through the Church to think of and pray for others and work for their Salvation through, for example, the Corporal and the Spiritual Works of Mercy. Lest we forget what our duty as Christians is, let us just recap on these.

The Corporal and Spiritual Works

The Corporal Works of Mercy are as follows:

- To feed the hungry;
 - To give drink to the thirsty;
 - To clothe the naked;
 - To harbour the harbourless;
 - To visit the sick;
 - To ransom the captive;
 - To bury the dead.
- The Spiritual Works of Mercy are:
- To instruct the ignorant;
 - To counsel the doubtful;
 - To admonish sinners;
 - To bear wrongs patiently;
 - To forgive offences willingly;
 - To comfort the afflicted;
 - To pray for the living and the dead.

The abomination of abortion

While reflecting recently on the abomination of abortion that is becoming so rife in our society, I questioned how I, myself, was proclaiming and promoting the sanctity of life of unborn babies and how I was addressing this plague that is being wilfully and wrongly

imposed on the Irish people.

Repealing Article 40.3.3

This is happening through, among other things, the recent demands for repealing Article 40.3.3 of the Irish Constitution, also known as the Eighth Amendment which upholds the unborn child's right to life. "The State acknowledges the right to life of the unborn and, with due regard to the equal right to life of the mother, guarantees in its laws to respect and, as far as practicable, by its laws to defend and vindicate that right." (Bunreacht na hÉireann)

This clause

This clause then equates the right to life of a pregnant woman with that of the baby in her womb and, in so doing, it criminalises abortion in all cases except where to continue a pregnancy would result in death. This is why the abortion movement - that promotes so vehemently, yet benignly, the culture of death - is so opposed to this Article being retained.

Pursuing this evil path

So, in our attempts to abide by what Jesus and the Church teach us - to admonish sinners - we should use all possible means and media to seek, in a loving and Christian way, to convince our brothers and sisters of the folly in pursuing this evil path. That it can only lead to

eternal perdition in hell. It is our responsibility to try and improve their spiritual plight and help them realise the Truth and escape the evil claws of the devil.

Abortion lobby is so strong

But how do we do this when the abortion lobby is so strong? It has the support of almost all shades of politics, of mass media, of the international (and national) courts, of major financiers and investors and of the majority of the population who are, likewise, being duped into believing that this is the proper thing to do, this is forward thinking, this is the only way to uphold women's rights etc. In short, this trend towards more lax laws concerning abortion has become the flavour of the month, matched only by the gay/lesbian agenda, another 'mass' movement which is equally flawed and demonic in its ideology and the spiritual repercussions of which are equally drastic.

Relying on God and prayer

The only way we can hope to influence people positively is through relying on God and prayer - we should bear in mind how, against all odds, He sent David out to slay Goliath, how He tumbled the walls of Jericho on the seventh day of prayer as the Israelites encircled the city seven times and how it was by faith that the Jewish people passed through the Red Sea as on dry land but when the Egyptians tried to follow, they were drowned.

Know and believe in Jesus

We should know and believe in Jesus, the One Who, by His Own volition and the Grace of God, was raised



from the dead on the third day. He is our Rock and our Strength and in Him we shall overcome all.

Mighty to God

As Pauls tells us:

"For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty to God unto the pulling down of fortifications, destroying counsels and every height that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every understanding unto the obedience of Christ and having in readiness to revenge all disobedience, when your obedience shall be fulfilled." (2 Corinthians 10:3-6)

Power and Grace of God

We should be constant in our obedience, in our prayer and in our witness and confident in the Power and Grace of God to move mountains and change hearts, in accordance with our faith.



Save the 8th

Great family spirit

EIGHTH AMENDMENT HAS SAVED 100,000 LIVES, GROUP CLAIMS

**Pro-Life Campaign releases report
on 33rd anniversary of abortion
referendum**

**The actuarial report
More than 100,000 lives have been**

saved in Ireland by the Eighth Amendment to the Constitution, a report from the Pro-Life Campaign has estimated.

The actuarial report was commissioned by the group "to show the Eighth Amendment is life-saving" and to challenge the assertion by those in favour of repealing the Amendment that it had not reduced the Irish abortion rate.

The report was published on Wednesday, which was the 33rd anniversary of the referendum which resulted in the Amendment being inserted into the Constitution.

The Amendment, Article 40.3.3, pledges to "defend and vindicate" the equal right to life of the unborn and the mother, "as far as practicable".

Pro-choice campaigners argue the Amendment has simply resulted in women having to travel abroad for abortion, and has not reduced the Irish abortion rate.

- Independent Alliance TDs may shift stance in abortion vote
- Over 5,600 Irish women sought abortion pills online
- Demand for abortion pills highlights need for change in the law

However, the Pro-Life Campaign said this claim was "mistaken".

"At a very conservative estimate there are tens of thousands of Irish people alive today precisely because of the protection that the Eighth Amendment gives to the unborn," the report says.

The report says that in 2014, some 5.2 per cent of pregnancies in Ireland were ended by abortion (performed outside the jurisdiction), while the rate in Sweden was 24 per cent, 21 per cent in England and Wales and 18 per cent in Spain.

Estimates

The report also estimates how many abortions would have been performed on Irish women between 1994 and 2014 if abortion rates in other countries prevailed here.

During this period, 108,000 abortions were performed on Irish women and girls in England and Wales.

According to the report, Ireland would have had 304,000 abortions over those 20 years if it had the abortion rate of England and Wales, which meant that some 196,000 pregnancies that would have been terminated were continued to term.



It estimates that if the Spanish rate prevailed here, there would have been 229,000 abortions over the period, meaning "121,000 Irish citizens would not have been born". The report does not look at how many of the terminations would have been of foetuses with fatal anomalies, or would have miscarried anyway, although the Pro-Life Campaign said its estimates were "conservative".

Asked whether there was a concern that many of the abortions not performed were a result of women or girls being unable to travel and forced to continue crisis pregnancies, Cora Sherlock, spokeswoman for the Pro-Life Campaign, said the point of the report was simply to open a "long overdue" discussion on the "truth that repeal of the Eighth Amendment would inevitably result in more lives being lost".
